2. The papers rejected in oral presentation will be considered for poster presentation subject to your willingness.
3. The papers rejected in poster presentation will not be entertained.

Guidelines for oral presentation:

- Seven minutes (7mts) will be given for each oral presentation and 2 minutes for discussion.
- The presentation will be in MS-PowerPoint.
- Participants are advised to rehearse for time and preview their PowerPoint presentation.
- Pen drives / CDs should be given to the projectionist one hour before their session.

Guidelines for poster presentation:

- The poster should be prepared in English.
- The poster should be self-explanatory even in the absence of the authors.
- Use of photographs, diagrams and tables will improve the quality of the poster.
- Title should be brief, informative and readable.
- For a poster to be effective, the text should be kept to a minimum - be clear and concise.
- Use bold type letter to enhance legibility.
- Lettering used for the heading should be at least 2.5cms high and that of text atleast 1.0cm but preferably larger.
- Poster presenters are responsible for mounting and removing their posters on the designated board by poster number.
- Materials for putting the posters on poster board will be provided by the Secretariat.
- The Poster Board will be 1.0metre x 1.5 metre in size.
- Hand-written material will not be permitted.
